Whom did Abraham love more - God or Isaac?

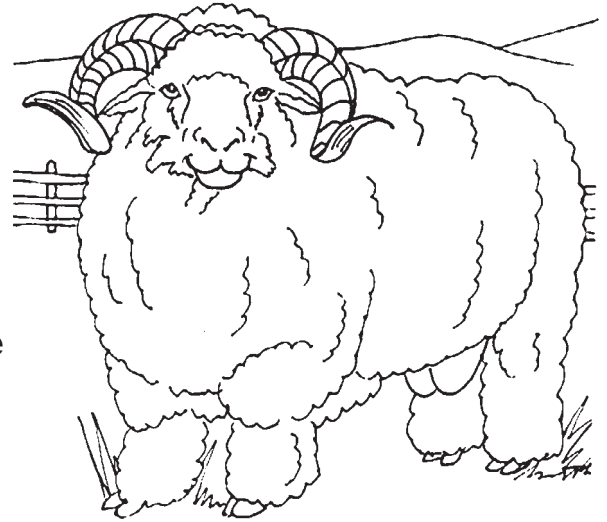
STORY 2: Abraham obeys God

This story is about: God showing the way.

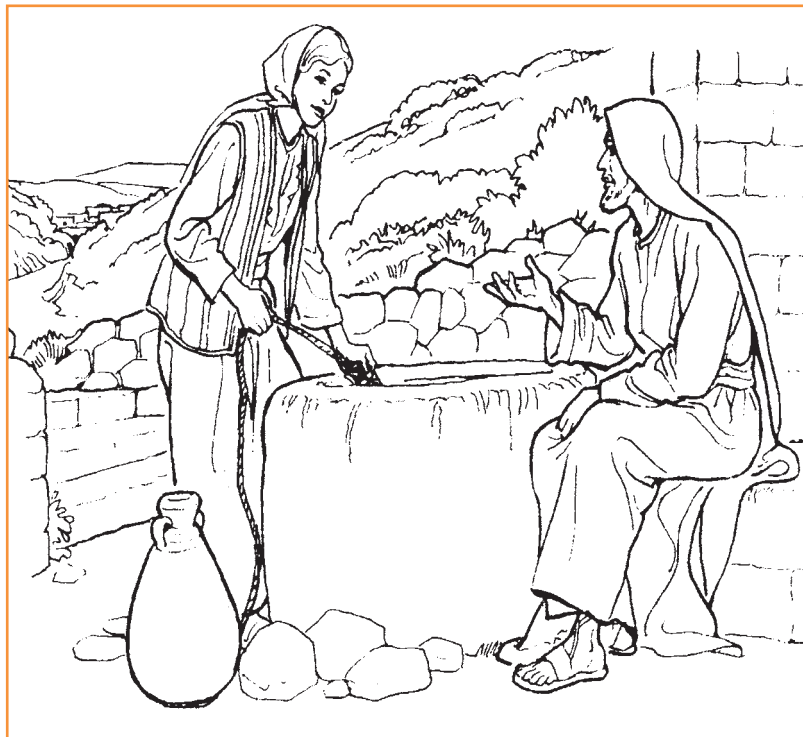


READ:
