This story is about: The coming of the Holy Spirit.



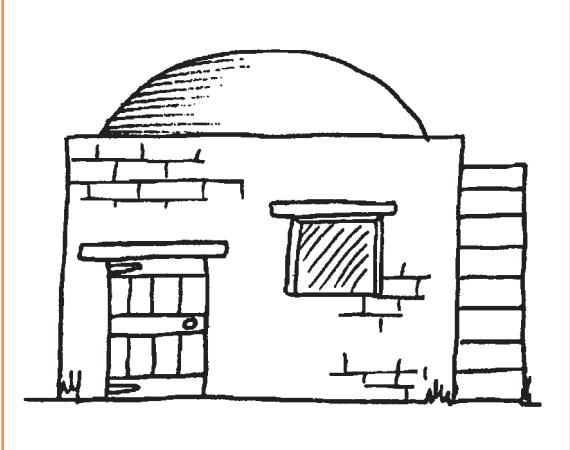

This story is about: God's healing power.



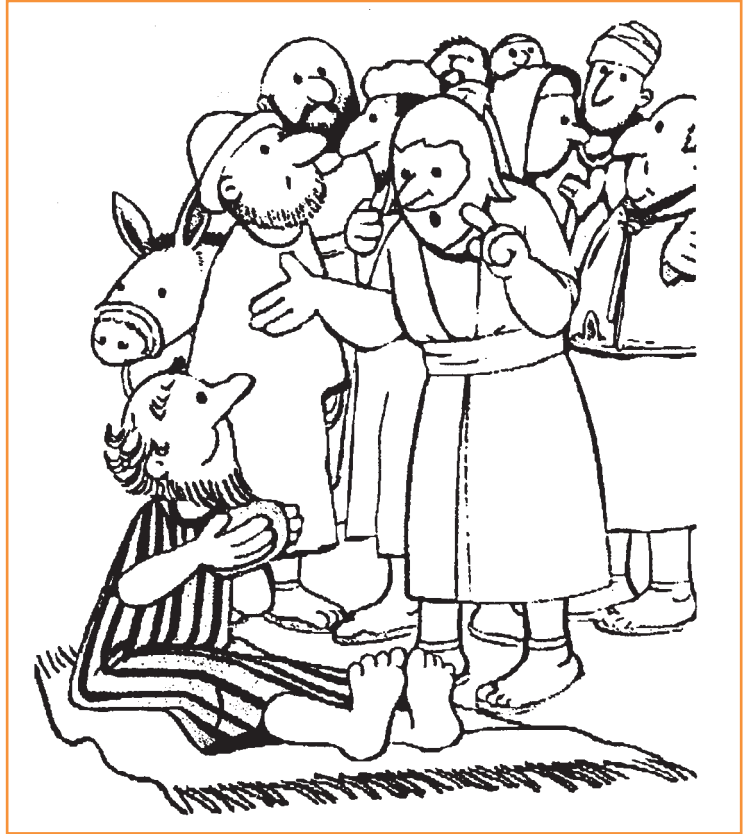
READ:

STORY 3: Peter in Prison.

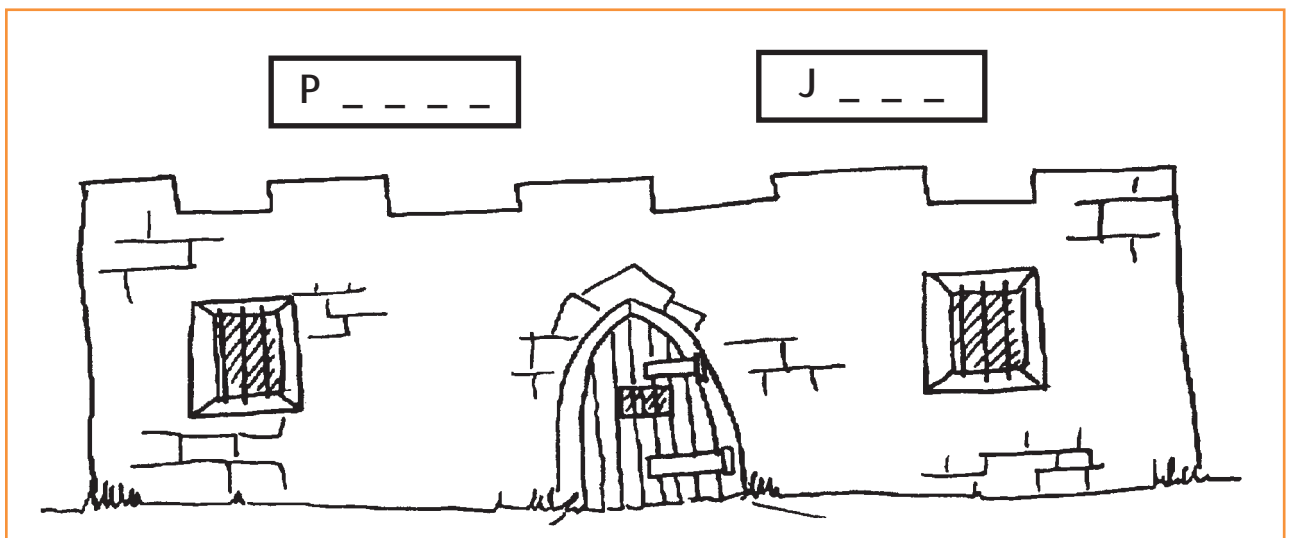
This story is about: How God helps those who serve him.

Acts 4: 23-31

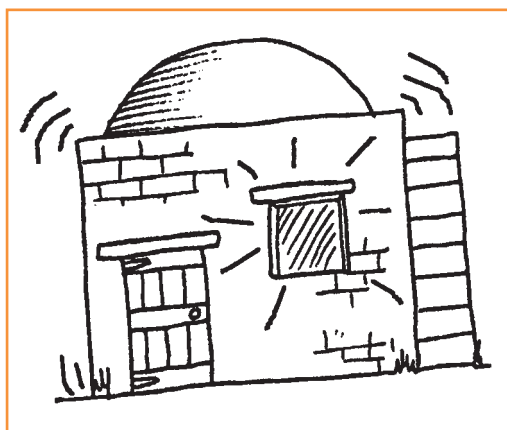
