But when Jesus came, Martha was too busy to be with Him. She still had so much to do. Instead, her sister, Mary, stayed with Jesus, learning from what He said.

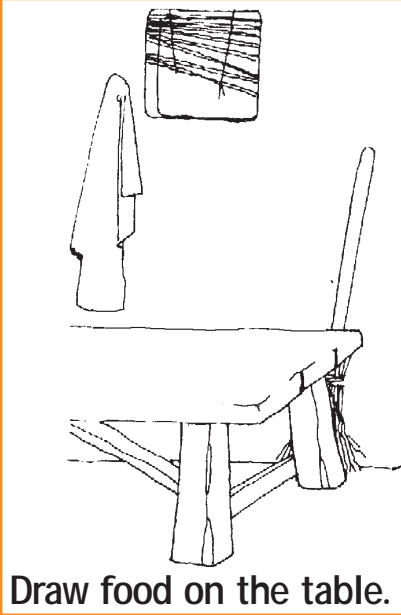
Soon Martha became cross with Mary. It wasn't fair that Mary had left her to do all the work. Martha came in and told Jesus to ask Mary to help her!

This story is about: Mary showing her love for Jesus.

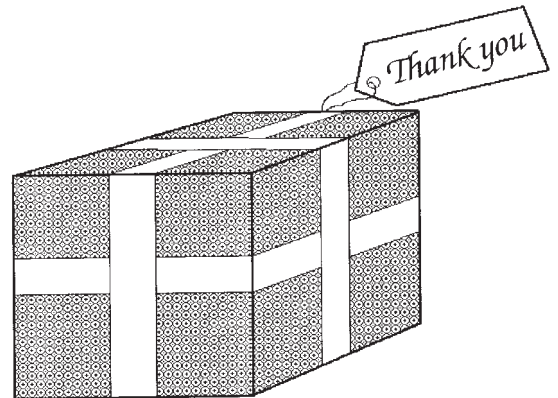

Have you ever given a 'Thank-you' present to someone who is very good to you?

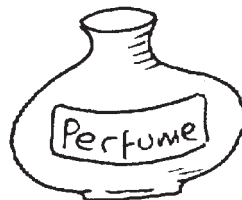
Mary and Martha were so pleased that Jesus had given them back their brother. They wanted to have a feast for Him.

STORY 4: Looking at Jesus.

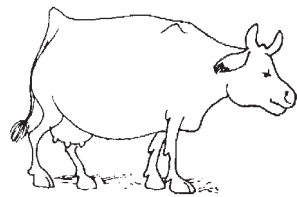
This story is about: Jesus being made welcome.



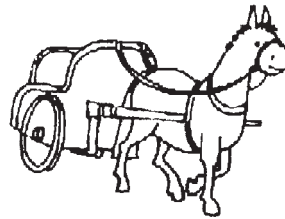
READ:

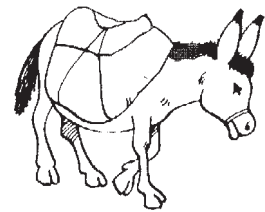
What did Jesus come riding on? Circle the correct answer.
